





Peely Wally is a lovely story about the adventures of Peely Wally's small and spotty egg. It is great for introducing a variety of animal names include zebra, giraffe and monkey.

Alliteration Alliteration is when two words begin with the same sound, for example, Mavis Monkey. What other examples can you and your child find in the book? You can find things and try to name then using alliteration such as Travis Train or Sammy Snake.



Paint an egg Peely Wally's egg is small and spotty. What other designs could you paint on an egg (either using an outline on paper or a hard-boiled egg)?



Fine Motor Control Being able to draw using a pen or pencil requires a level of control in the hand and finger muscles. Lots of different activities will help this including playing with playdough and tracing letters in sand, gloop or foam. Why not encourage your child to follow the path that Peely Wally's eggs takes by tracing the dotted line with one of their fingers? You could then draw more complicated paths for them to trace or encourage them to make their own path.
