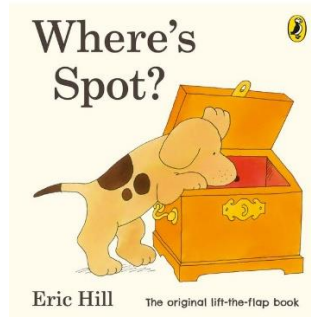


Where's Spot?

Where's Spot? is the modern classic by Eric Hill. In fact, the first Spot book was written over 40 years ago. Does anyone in your family remember reading about Spot the dog when they were younger?

Prepositions: These are words which describe where something is located such as under or in. There are lots of different prepositions in the book. Can your child put teddy bear (or another toy) **on** the table, **under** the bed or **in** the cupboard?



Whilst looking for Spot, his Mum (Sally) finds lots of animals hidden in her house such as a snake, hippopotamus and monkey. Help your child to name the different animals. You could always have a discussion about where they would be found in the wild.
